- 2005 RA Conference had to be postponed due to the impact of Hurricane Katrina. It was scheduled to be held on the Campus of the University of South Alabama during the weekend of October 15, but due to the influx of people staying on campus at USA, they are looking at a date in February or March to hold the conference.
- Discussion occurred on combining the ALURH conference with the RA conference. It was decided that it was not feasible at this time to hold them both together.
- Funding was requested by ALURH for an “ALAHO Student of the Year” award and for assistance with a hospitality room at the ALURH conference. Funding was approved.
- ALURH conference will be held January 20-22 on the campus of the University of Alabama, Birmingham.
