The SCORE 2005 Conference was hosted by Furman University on February 4-5, 2005 and was successful. The conference was held at the Hyatt Regency Downtown Greenville and the conference theme was JUNGLE, standing for Jointly Uniting Neighbors for a Growing and Learning Environment.

#### SCORE/SCHOA Partnership.

Napolean Melton or SCORE shared a proposal with me, the SCHOA president, and SCHOA past-president that outlines a partnership between SCHOA and SCORE that would benefit both parties in the areas of programming, communication/promotion, brand association, and sponsorship/fundraising.
