Progress Since Last Report:

The fifth annual Southern Placement Exchange (SPE) will be held on March 9 – 12, 2006 in Memphis, Tennessee at the Holiday Inn and Fogelman Executive Center on the University of Memphis Campus. As of this date, the Holiday Inn and Fogelman Center are booked. Park Place Hotel has special rate for SPE attendants and is only a few miles from the University of Memphis.

Registration is still ongoing for both employers and candidates. As of this date, there has been 66 employers registered, 72 candidates registered, and 96 jobs advertised. There are positions posted in the following areas: Career Services, Residence Life, Student Activities, Student Affairs, Judicial Affairs, Greek Affairs, and Counseling.

The entire registration process is on-line. The candidates and employers are able to submit resume information and position postings.

There will be a display for each sponsoring organization set up at this year's Placement Exchange. This will help to acknowledge the sponsoring organizations and give more information about each Association to the participants.
